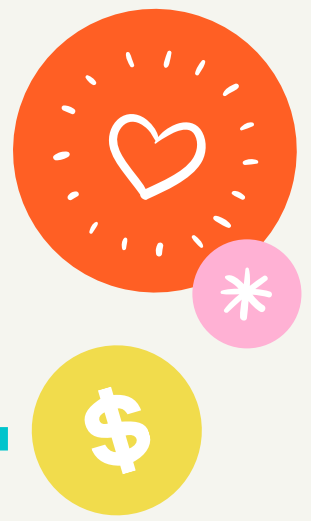


2021 OUT OF SCHOOL TIME FINAL REPORT

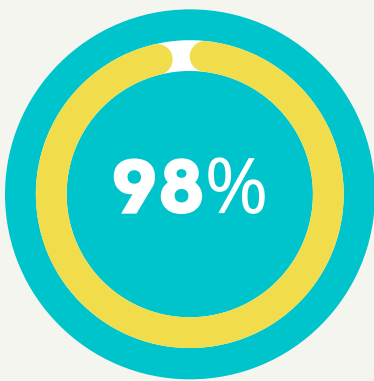
\$125 000

In Summer 2021, the OST Collaborative funders - the United Way, the Butler Family Foundation, and the City of Edmonton - provided \$125 000 to support the 2021 OST Summer Funding Grant. 11 funded programs provided summer programming for over 730 children and youth.



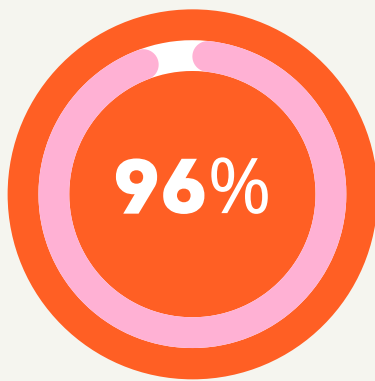

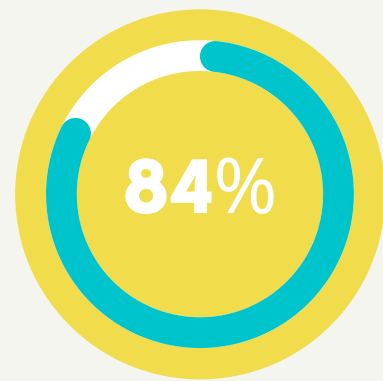

SUCCESS STORY (ONE OF MANY!)

"A team member asked the children what they would do when they were too angry to talk to a team member or friend. One child responded with 'go to our treehouse'. We taught the children daily how to meditate by using the idea of building a treehouse in their head. This activity was very efficient and the children were able to take this tool home with them and use it in the future as a self-management technique."
